The goal is to help students to continue their studies, or to explore their interests in the visual arts. The value of individual bursary will depend on the level of financial assistance required and on the availability of funds.

### Eligibility

This Bursary Program is open to everyone who would like to enroll in a visual art course at the Ottawa School of Art. Children, youth, adults and seniors, with or without any prior visual arts experience or education, but who shows a genuine interest and require financial assistance are encouraged to apply.

#### Value

The value of the individual bursary will depend on the level of financial assistance required and available funds.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### Summer camps for children ages 6-12 years

Students produce a wide variety of work in all disciplines: drawing, painting, printmaking, collage and sculpture. These classes give students the opportunity to use materials and processes that are not available in the home or school setting.

### Summer camps for teens ages 13-15 years

The OSA also offers classes for older children between 13 and 15 years. These classes are media specific and encourage students to focus their attention and develop patience using a narrower range and techniques while having fun in either cartooning, painting, sculpture, drawing etc.




## SI4C3D | VAN GOGH AND FRIENDS: DRAWING AND PAINTING EMPHASIS | AGES II – I2



You are about to become a modern day artisan. Your training starts now!
