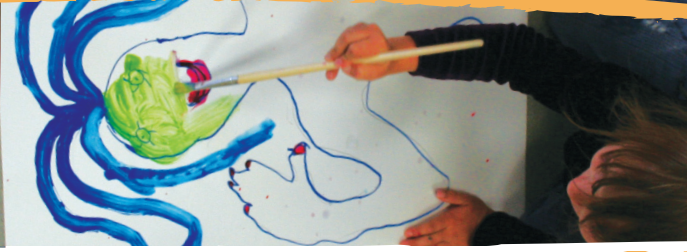


ART FOR EVERYONE!



OSA OUTREACH PROGRAM

The OSA Outreach Program provides barrier-free community-based visual arts classes to children and youth living in underprivileged situations and that are facing economic or social barriers to cultural activities.

These art classes encourage the participants to be creative, to develop their personal potential, and to participate in the community while building their self esteem.

Schoolteachers, social service agencies and community workers refer participants to the program.

The children (ages 6 to 12) and youth (ages 13 to 25) register for free through their neighbourhood community centre, community house or local social service provider. There are no tuition fees, all the art materials are provided, and take-home art supplies are offered to the participants at the end of each term.

The Outreach Program classes are modeled on the Ottawa School of Art's well respected high quality art programming.

Professional artist-instructors develop and teach the classes with the help of community resource persons. The student-to-instructor ratio is kept low to ensure the participants receive individual attention and personal guidance.

Classroom assistants and volunteers from within the community help the artist-instructors during the classes and healthy snack breaks.

The art classes are taught in neighbourhood community centres and community houses easily accessible to the participants.
