This class will offer a sound introduction to the use of watercolour. Students will learn colour mixing, brush handling and other techniques through exercises based on still life, photographs and painting from the figure. Three model sessions.

Paper:

Pack of five 140lb. Arches or Windsor & Newton

Brushes:

#6 sable or the best you can afford

Miscellaneous:

Mixing tray with lid

Masking tape

Kneadable eraser

Lightweight drawing board (coroplast)

HB pencil

2 plastic tubs or jars

Paints: buy the best you can afford, tubes are more versatile

Ultramarine blue

Cobalt blue

Cadmium red medium

Alizarin Crimson

Permanent rose (good but not necessary)

Yellow ochre

Cadmium yellow medium

Lemon or aureole yellow

Phthalo green or veridian green

Raw umber

Burnt umber

Burnt sienna

Ivory black or Payne's grey {blacks are not absolutely necessary}
